It is dedicated to protecting and empowering teen girls from sexual abuse in Tanzania. Timeless Bonds has a multifaceted strategy that is geared towards protecting and empowering endangered youths, specifically vulnerable teen girls.

Sexual violence against teen girls, especially aged 16-19, constitutes a global crisis, with research indicating that 82% of all victims of such violence are female. In Tanzania, a survey revealed alarming rates of childhood sexual violence, with approximately 28% of females aged 13-24 reporting experiences of such abuse before the age of 18, highlighting the pervasive nature of the issue and its profound health repercussions.

At Timeless Bonds we are dedicated to fostering a supportive and inclusive environment that empowers our target audience, girl survivors of sexual violence, to thrive through growth, education, and achievement. We are moved by the mission to provide platforms that enable these individuals to make meaningful contributions to their communities, driving positive change. Our mission is to provide a haven for our clients offering holistic support and resources to help them reclaim their lives and futures. NEED STATEMENT

In the shadows of our communities, a silent epidemic persists- one that preys upon the most vulnerable among us and leaves a trail of devastation in its wake. It is the insidious plague of sexual violence and oppression, manifesting in various forms of abuse, exploitation, and degradation, with its most sinister manifestations directed at our endangered youths, particularly females.

The reality is stark and sobering: countless young girls face the daily threat of sexual abuse, a heinous crime that robs them of their innocence, their dignity, and their future. From the dark corners of the internet to the seemingly safe confines of their own homes, no place is immune to the reach of this pervasive evil. And yet, all too often, their cries for help go unheard, their suffering overlooked, and their trauma silenced by fear and shame. The plague cuts across every nation but is very prevalent among low-income regions like Africa, specifically Tanzania, which is the target area of our organization.

The scope of the problem is staggering. Statistics paint a grim picture of the prevalence and impact of sexual abuse on our youth, with alarming rates of victimization and long-term consequences for survivors. According to recent data, globally, the prevalence of CSA for girls varies between 2 and 62%, while it is estimated that between 14 and 25% of women and children have experienced rape during their lifetime. In low-income countries precisely Africa, nearly one out of every three (33%) African girls has been a victim of sexual violence in their life. In Tanzania alone, the National Survey on Violence Against Children (VAC) provides national estimates of the magnitude and nature of sexual, physical, and emotional violence experienced by girls. The estimates show that violence against children is so serious that, at the age of 18, more than a quarter of girls (28%) have experienced sexual violence. More than 60% of girls who did not disclose incidences of sexual violence to anyone gave family or community reasons- the most common reason being fear of abandonment or separation from family, fear of being beaten, and of no one believing their story.

Sexual abuse is associated with a range of consequences. Some of these consequences are direct, such as acute injuries, sexually transmitted infections (STIs) including HIV, and unwanted pregnancies. These can leave the child with shattered hopes for the future, emotionally bankrupt, chronic somatic disorders, anxiety, depression, high-risk sexual behavior, chronic illnesses, and socio-economic consequences that generally impact negatively on the victim's quality of life. Again, sexual abuse has been linked to several factors that can expose the victims to such violence; poor education, poverty, coercion, poor family background etcetera.

Amidst this harrowing landscape of despair and desolation, there is a pressing need for intervention- a call to action that demands our collective attention and unwavering commitment. Several organizations and initiatives are working to address this issue. Organizations like 'Timeless Bonds' are at the forefront of this critical mission, offering a beacon of hope and refuge for those who have been victimized and marginalized by society's indifference. Our programs and services are designed to address the multifaceted needs of survivors, providing not only immediate crisis intervention and support but also long-term healing and empowerment. Through accommodation, counseling, advocacy, education, empowerment and community outreach, we strive to break the cycle of violence and oppression, empowering our clients to reclaim their lives and their dignity. Yet, our efforts are hampered by limited resources and an overwhelming need to reach out to more young girls- widen our horizon. The need for expanded services, enhanced outreach, and greater community engagement is urgent and undeniable.

Currently, we are considering, expanding our farmland to increase productivity. This will provide necessary revenue for our organization's operations repeatedly and will serve as a means of livelihood to our clients, as it will be used as a tool for them to learn good agricultural practices and basic crop production. With your support we can bolster our capacity to serve those in need, providing a lifeline of hope and healing to countless young girls who are at risk of falling through the cracks of society.

Therefore, we humbly appeal for your support in our quest to secure funding for the expansion of our farmland. Your partnership is not just an investment in our organization-it is an investment in the future of our youth, our communities, and our society as a whole. Together, we can shine a light into the darkness of social violence and oppression, offering hope, healing, and a path to a brighter tomorrow for all.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Our nonprofit organization has been working hand-in-hand with the Franciscan sisters, who manage five convents across Tanzania, to provide a beacon of hope for sexually abused teen girls. One of these convents is a hub of learning, hosting 40 catechists who study for two years before returning to their villages to teach. Despite our collective efforts, the sisters struggle to make ends meet, barely scraping by with enough food to survive and often lacking the funds to support their charitable work.

We are determined to help the sisters overcome these challenges, which have hindered our ability to deliver top-notch

services. Our goals are ambitious: we aim to expand our reach by establishing more Safe-havens, increase our intake capacity, and address the sisters' agricultural challenges. A donated land has already been secured for the first Safe-haven, with plans for similar structures in Tonga, Moshi, and Arushi.

To address the sisters' agricultural challenges, we plan to expand their farm to support 100 cows, raise 1000 free-range chickens, develop a bee program, and increase their pig population from 12 to 100. This will provide enough milk, meat, eggs, and pork for their needs, as well as surplus for sale. Under the leadership of Sister Victoria, a trained veterinarian, the sisters will work tirelessly to bring our collective vision to life.

We will hire 20 extra villagers, paying a respectable wage, to help with the additional workload. A clear leadership structure will be established, with each animal area having a leader reporting to Sister Victoria, Sister Emanuel, and finally the Mother Superior. This project has the potential to make a significant impact on the community, providing food for starving families, supporting the education of the girls, and creating a sustainable and profitable operation.

With the right support, the sisters can make a real difference in the lives of those around them, specifically our clients, and create a brighter future for generations to come. This project aims for long-term sustainability, with no recurring funding needed. Together, we can empower the sisters to continue their vital work and provide a beacon of hope for sexually abused teen girls.

2. **Safe house Enhancements:** There are two safe houses in Tanzania, which have saved about 500 teen girls' lives from sexual abuse. Our nonprofit has one that is larger and can accommodate more girls, and we are considering opening more safe houses in Tonga, Moshi and Arushi. We are considering raising the number of intakes from (12) to (18). However, we continuously assess and enhance the facilities and resources within our safe house to ensure they meet the highest standards of safety, security, and comfort for survivors. This may involve regular maintenance, security upgrades, and improvements to living spaces and amenities.

3. **Qualified Staff and Training:** With a skilled team comprising counselors, advisors, financial experts, and project/program coordinators, we are well-equipped to offer specialized care and support to our clients. Our professionals undergo continuous training to stay updated on the latest practices, strategies, and approaches essential for delivering high-quality services. This includes training in trauma-informed care, cultural competency, and best practices for supporting survivors of sexual abuse. For our Farm expansion initiative, there is Sister Victoria, a well trained veterinarian to spearhead the operation. While we intend to employ extra 20 individuals from the communities to assist. By investing in ongoing professional development, we ensure that our team remains at the forefront of excellence, providing compassionate and effective support to those in need.

4. **Collaborative Partnerships:** At present, we have established a valuable partnership with the Franciscan Sisters in Sanya Juu, who oversee five convents across Tanzania. Leveraging their expertise and support, we seek their guidance

and collaboration in aiding our future clients. Prospectively, we aspire to forge strategic alliances with local government agencies, law enforcement, healthcare providers, legal aid organizations, and other service providers. Through collaborative efforts, we aim to strengthen the continuum of care for survivors, facilitating seamless referrals, case management, and coordinated services to ensure each survivor receives comprehensive support. These partnerships are integral to our mission of providing holistic care and empowering survivors on their journey to healing and resilience.

There would be high resilience in fundraising by continuing to ensure financial efficiency in operation while delivering effective company outcomes.

SUSTAINABILITY AND DISSEMINATION

Below is a comprehensive sustainability and dissemination plan outlining strategic initiatives to expand our farm operations and enhance the long-term sustainability and impact of our nonprofit organization. These strategies encompass revenue generation, community engagement, collaboration, monitoring and evaluation, and long-term sustainability planning.

FARM EXPANSION FOR SUSTAINABLE REVENUE GENERATION

This is the primary objective of our grant proposal- to expand our existing farm operations to generate sustainable revenue streams for our nonprofit organization.

With the grant funding obtained in this year's funding cycle, we intend to invest in the expansion of our farm infrastructure, including acquiring additional land to establish more Safe-haven, purchasing farming equipment, and implementing sustainable agricultural practices. We aim to expand our farm to support 100 cows, which would allow for adequate milk and meat production, for consumption as well as for sale. We also plan to raise 1000 free-range chickens, providing eggs and chicken for sale. Additionally, we intend to develop a bee program with stingless and stinging bees to sell honey, honeycombs, and wax. Finally, we aim to increase our pig population from 12 to 100, selling pork in the market to meet the demand for fresh meat.

This expansion will facilitate our capacity to produce high-quality crops and enough livestock hence an increase in productivity and consequent increase in the generation of revenue through sales to local markets, restaurants, and community-supported agriculture programs.

By diversifying our revenue sources in this manner, we will reduce dependency on external funding and enhance the financial sustainability of our organization in the coming years. The revenue from the farm will support the operational costs of our programs and services, ensuring their continuity and long-term impact. Another impact this will have on our organization is that our clients will leverage on this commercial farming experience to learn excellent agricultural practices and basic crop production.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT AND AWARENESS

The objective is to raise awareness about our organization's mission, programs, and impact within the local community and beyond.

We will engage in targeted outreach efforts, including community events, workshops, and educational sessions, to disseminate information about our services and the importance of supporting survivors of sexual abuse.
